Main function

To ensure that Rangers are kept fully informed of developments and opportunities at National, Regional and County levels.

Specific Functions

- To keep all Rangers informed of opportunities within and out with the County.
- To provide opportunities for Rangers to meet as a group across the County.
- To encourage Rangers to go forward for International Selection.
- To give advice and support to Ranger Section volunteers.
- To liaise with International, Duke of Edinburgh Award, Queen's Guide and Outdoor Advisers as appropriate.
- To ensure that all relevant people are kept up-to-date with Ranger developments and programme changes.
- Attend Growing Guiding meetings.

Appointed by County Commissioner and approved by County Executive.

Term of appointment is three years with an option of two additional years.
